Getting no divine guidance, not by dreams, nor Urim, nor prophets, in desperation he sought a spirit medium.

The message of this spirit that looked like Samuel was true for the most part, but the spirit lied when it said, "Tomorrow you and your sons will be with me." It was devilishly structured to throw Saul into despair. There was no hope, no help, no encouragement. Saul collapsed on the floor of the witch's cave and revived enough to eat only at the urging of the witch and Saul's two helpers. The words of the spirit became a selffulfilling prophecy.

The ancient warnings against spirit mediums and any who seek information from the dead are still true today. The dead are dead. Anyone who seeks information from them, whether by Ouija boards. horoscopes, or spiritists of any kind, is really talking with demons. Our safety lies only in seeking wisdom from God.

As we read the following Bible verses that constitute an Old Testament worship service, let us reflect on our giving as worship.

2 Chronicles 29:27-31: Hezekiah gave the order to sacrifice the burnt offering on the altar. As the offering began, singing to the Lord began also, accompanied by trumpets and the instruments of David, king of Israel. The whole assembly bowed in worship, while the musicians played and the trumpets sounded. All this continued until the sacrifice of the burnt offering was completed. When the offerings were finished, the king and everyone present with him knelt down and worshiped. King Hezekiah and his officials ordered the Levites to praise the Lord with the words of David and of Asaph the seer. So they sang praises with gladness and bowed down and worshiped. Then Hezekiah said, "You have now dedicated yourselves to the Lord. Come and bring sacrifices and thank offerings to the temple of the Lord." So the assembly brought sacrifices and thank offerings, and all whose hearts were willing brought burnt offerings.
